Greetings, Friends and Families of Palisades Episcopal School,

In 2006, a group of visionaries founded Palisades Episcopal School (PES). They envisioned a Christ-centered school that would instill values, inspire creativity and develop individuality in its students - an environment where children's innate enthusiasm for learning would be cultivated so it could serve them for a lifetime. They dreamed of graduates who would leave PES with strong moral compasses, prepared in every way to be world changers.

Opening in rented classrooms at Camp Thunderbird, with only 25 students in kindergarten through fourth grade, PES is now situated on a nine-acre campus in the heart of the Palisades community. A combination of permanent buildings, our Browning Recreation Center, and modular classrooms has allowed our student population to blossom to over 260 students in junior kindergarten through eighth grade. Seventeen years and over 130 graduates later, PES is a thriving community that has exceeded all expectations.

As the rising demand for a PES education exceeds what our current facilities can support, PES is launching our \$4,500,000 Room to Bloom Capital Campaign to build a new, first-rate academic building that can accommodate our increasing student population. This transformational new facility will allow PES to remove our modular classrooms and move all students into permanent facilities. It will also provide PES with much-needed room to grow our enrollment to 350 students over the next five years.
